TENNIS COURT



DRESS CODE

A strictly monitored dress code is observed on the tennis courts at the Royal South Yarra Lawn Tennis Club. Failure to adhere to the dress code will result in a player being asked to change or leave the courts.



GENTLEMEN PERMITTED ATTIRE:

Made-for-tennis shirt with sleeves, made-for-tennis shorts and made-for-tennis shoes with socks.

Whilst a predominantly white outfit is preferred, gentlemen may wear a coloured top without collar, and coloured shorts, provided the entire outfit is made-for-tennis.





Made-for-tennis dress or made-for-tennis top with skirt or shorts and made-for-tennis shoes with socks.

Whilst a predominantly white outfit is preferred, ladies may wear a coloured top without collar and/or sleeves with a coloured skirt or shorts, provided the entire outfit is made-for-tennis.

Leggings and compression clothing (including bicycle shorts and skins) may be worn on the tennis courts, but only under approved tennis attire. Made-for-tennis track pants, track tops, jumpers and vests may be also worn on the courts.

The following dress is **NOT** permitted on the tennis courts

- Any clothing or X feetwear that is not made-for-tennis
 - Sleeveless shirts X
 - Street clothes ×
- Clothing with large × logos, slogans, or messages
